REAL CLEAR POLITICS, an Internet Polling Organization who averages all currently reliable polls, is showing **Marsha Blackburn** ahead of Phil Bredesen by 6.5 points. **Bill Lee** is up by 14 points in the Governor’s Race. They are showing the projected new Senate to be GOP 53, Democrats 47. Indiana & Florida are still too close to call. They

are currently leaning Democratic, but new polls show those races tightening so stay tuned. Today, the House looks 205 seats for Democrats, 199 for Republicans with 31 seats too close to call. However, all but one of those toss-up seats are currently held by Republicans. 218 seats are needed to reach a majority in the House.
