Now that former Congressman Stephen Fincher & current Senator Bob Corker have announced retirement from the Senate Race, Marsha Blackburn is opposed only by a newcomer, Dr. Rolando Toyos in the GOP Primary. This week, Blackburn received the endorsement from 18 sitting Tennessee State Senators including Sen. Rusty Crowe, Delores Gresham, Jack Johnson, Bill Ketron, Brian Kelsey, and our own Mark Green among others. Mark Green is currently running for Blackburn's vacant Congressional Seat in District 7. A poll this week by Ranger Research Partners

showed Blackburn leading Corker by 48% to 29%. 926 likely Republican Voters were polled.

According to the Nashville TENNESSEAN, Nashville police are formulating new policies for officers assigned to protect Mayor Megan Barry after a former bodyguard earned tens of thousands of dollars in overtime while he had an affair with Mayor Barry. TBI found that former Sgt. Rob Forrest earned more than \$170,000 in overtime pay since Barry took office in September, 2015. Forrest took the Mayor to a wide array of events which included Hot Yoga, late-night concerts & expensive restaurants.
